MILITARY SAVES WEEK 2015

Military Saves Week is an annual opportunity for installations and organizations to promote good savings behavior and a chance for service members and their families to assess their own savings status. Military Saves Week is February 23-28, 2015. The goal is to encourage service members and their families to take the Military Saves pledge, a commitment to begin the journey toward financial freedom. We promote positive changes in personal financial behavior through the notion that everyone can “Start Small, Think Big.” The 2015 theme is “Set a Goal. Make a Plan. Save Automatically.” This week is used as an opportunity to encourage service members to save automatically through direct deposit; to save towards a goal like an emergency fund, a home, or retirement.

Did You Know?

- Only 51% of Americans say they have a savings plan with a specific goal.
- 45% of military families say they have not set



aside sufficient emergency funds to cover at least three months' worth of expenses.

- 60% of military families express that they feel stress from their family's current financial condition.
- 50% of service members say they have too much debt.
- 39% of military members with credit cards only pay the minimum amount due each month.
- 38% of military members are underwater on their home loans.

ClearPoint and our VSO partners are all too familiar with the statistics that plague our veterans and service members. As a part of Military Saves Week, we encourage our participants to take advantage of our Personalized Learning Program (PLP). Courses are available free of charge on topics such as: Managing Your Credit, Managing Your Debt, Budgeting Basics, Reshaping Your Credit, Managing Financial Stress, Understanding Military Benefits, etc. Visit our programs by referring to page 6 of this newsletter for more information.

PERSONALIZED LEARNING PROGRAM

Many veterans have difficulty reconnecting to civilian life after leaving the Armed Forces. The ClearPoint Reconnect program helps veterans identify local resources that can help them manage financial challenges, identify and achieve financial goals, and build economic security for

themselves and their families. This program offers financial counseling and comprehensive online education with monthly touch points via email, web and telephone. The online education is self-guided and interactive, with customized courses, guided activities, tools and resources. Intake/exit assessments and pre/post-

exams gauge learner success while gamification features allow learners to earn program credits for badges or other partner specific incentives. The Reconnect program is available to active duty members, military veterans and their families.

Foster camaraderie in your community.

TRAGEDY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR SURVIVORS (TAPS)

On Feb. 3, after months of advocacy by surviving family members and veterans service organizations, Congress passed the Clay Hunt Suicide Prevention for American Veterans Act. President Obama signed it into law on Thursday, Feb. 12, surrounded by representatives of the Tragedy Assistance Program for Survivors

(TAPS) who are family members of America's fallen heroes that died by suicide. "TAPS is pleased to see the Clay Hunt SAV Act signed into law. Making sure our service members, veterans, and their family members get the care they need is a top priority for TAPS. We are proud to partner with the Iraq and Afghanistan Vet-

erans of America (IAVA) to help ensure more families don't suffer the loss of their loved one to suicide" Director of Postvention Programs for TAPS Kim Ruocco said. "TAPS provides direct support for the thousands of survivors of suicide loss by offering programs which foster hope and healing, and a 24/7 helpline staffed by peer professionals."

MILITARY SPOUSE CORPORATE CAREER NETWORK (MSCCN)

In September 2014, IBM, and Corporate America Supports You and Military Corporate Career Network (CASY-MSCCN) successfully conducted an i2 Analyst's Notebook software training session, followed by a certification exam. Additionally, IBM's Kenexa Software was used as an assessment tool to confirm the credentials of the trainees. As a result, 90% of the

trainees attained this distinguished certification, and CASY-MSCCN is currently assisting the candidates with job placement. In 2015, IBM will continue to grow this program through an additional grant to CASY-MSCCN with job placement, based on their newly acquired skills.
